



**JVA World Challenge  
Houston, TX  
March 30th – April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012**

We will be flying Delta Airlines this year to Houston. Although they have a \$25 per bag fee, they were the airline that offered the lowest fare and the best schedule. The cost for the player ticket is \$411.53. The ticket fee will be included in your February invoice.

**Thursday, March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

We are flying Delta Airlines and our flight leaves Ft Myers (SW FL International Airport) at 8:30am arriving in Atlanta on flight 2352 at 10:23am. The connecting flight leaves Atlanta at 11:50am arriving in Houston on flight 1675 at 1:06pm. Players will need to be at the airport by **6:30am** to check in. When you arrive at the airport Delta Airlines will be  $\frac{3}{4}$  down the passenger drop off area – use door 5 to enter the airport.

**Monday, April 2nd, 2012**

Flight leaves Houston at 11:37am arriving in Atlanta on flight 2341 at 2:38pm  
Flight leaves Atlanta at 4:20pm arriving in Ft Myers on flight 1096 at 6:08pm

**Traveling Tips, Requirements and Suggestions**

**Players must have identification** – Drivers License or Passport. If you don't have either it is recommended that you bring your School ID with a copy of birth certificate.

**Luggage:** There is a \$25 per bag fee each way for checked bags. If players are planning on checking a bag, please make sure that you bring an extra \$50. Checked luggage must be less than 50 lbs. You are allowed 1 carry on and 1 personal item. Please keep in mind that what you bring with you, you are responsible for.

**Packing list:** volleyball uniforms for 3 days of tournament play (socks, shoes, knee pads, spandex, uniform jerseys, warm-up shirts, pants and jacket plus hair ties, ankle wear and your under garments), casual clothes to wear when you are not on the courts, personal hygiene items, PJ's, cell phone charger, money, snacks, etc...

**Carry on luggage** must be able to fit under your seat or in the overhead compartment. You can carry on food/snacks but no drinks. If you are going to carry on liquids, you must follow TSA's rules: 3.4 ounce (100ml) bottle or less (by volume); 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; 1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin. One-quart bag per person is the total liquid volume each traveler can bring.

**Money** – you will need money for meals (2 meals on Thursday, 1 on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and 2 meals on Monday) plus extra money for a tournament shirt, activities off the court, etc.
